Right to Bid – land opposite social club – S Golton had advised PE outside of the meeting that there were two applications submitted have been accepted by LCC And therefore next step(s). The original letter from LCC suggests that in lodging an intent to bid, there will be a 6 months moratorium on the development.

PE to write to the Rothwell Record updating their article whereby it was stated the CVNF and Incredible Edible were launching the bid. He will state it is our intention to support the application where psossible.

- 5.9.2. Carlton Hall Tree preservation info has been recycled form previous application. PE raised comments.


#### 5.10 AOB
